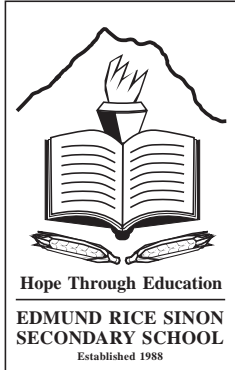

SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR FORM ONE APPLICANTS AND THEIR FAMILIES:

1. This Form costs 500/-, payable upon collection.
2. A non-refundable fee of 3 000/- is payable for the examination, payable upon the return of this form.
3. This form must be returned to the school at least two days prior to the Entrance Interview examination and must contain one recent passport sized picture of the student – no one will be allowed to sit the examination without their picture. For the examinations, the student needs only to bring a pen.
4. The first offers of places for the following year will be made following the initial Entrance Interview Tests which will take place at the school on the fourth Saturday in October at 9.00 am and/or 11.00 am. Details of this are available on the Application Form - see details below for obtaining a copy of this Form.
5. The list of successful candidates from these initial Entrance Interview Tests will be published at the school and in the Enrolment Information section of the website within the first week after the Interview. Acceptance of places offered must be made by the date specified in the Joining Instructions - **otherwise the offer is withdrawn and the place becomes available for the second round of offers.**
6. The second opportunity for receiving an offer of a place in Form One occurs in the first week of January with the second sitting of the Entrance Interview Tests to take place on the Wednesday at the school at 9.00 am and/or 11.00 am. Details of this are available on the Application Form - see details below for obtaining a copy of this Form.
7. The list of successful candidates from this second sitting of the Entrance Interview Tests will be published at the school and in the News or Enrolment Information section of the website within three days of the Entrance Interview Test. Acceptance of places offered must be made by the date specified in the Joining Instructions - **otherwise the offer is withdrawn and the place becomes available for students on our Waiting List or late applicants who will also be required to sit for the Entrance Interview Test.**
8. Late applications may be made but the availability of places is very doubtful as the school receives many more applications than places available.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School is a school for both girls and boys and was started in 1988 and has expanded to include A-Level since 2005.
2. The school is managed by the Congregation of Christian Brothers for the Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha.
3. The school welcomes students of all faiths – all are offered Religion classes in their own Religion.
4. The school administration reserves the right to dismiss any student who fails to attain a specified minimum standard or whose behaviour does not deserve a place at the school.
5. Boarding accommodation is offered to both girls and boys. Hostel accommodation is also offered to both girls and boys. Day students are most welcome and comprise about one-third of our students.
6. The fees are adjusted annually and the latest information on fees is available from the information provided in the Enrolment Information section of the website.
7. All students are offered lunch with the cost included in the school fee.
8. **All accommodation costs must normally be covered by the family. Where sponsorship is offered, it is normally only available to assist with the tuition fee.**
9. Regular transport services between Friends' Corner and the school operate both morning and evening.
10. Classes for Forms One to Four will commence in the second week of January on a date to be specified with all boarders in residence by 5.00 pm on the previous one or two days as specified. School commences at 8.15 am each day and finishes at 3.30 pm.
11. Enrolment procedures are under the direct control of the Headmaster who reserves the right to alter these guidelines in any specific instance.
