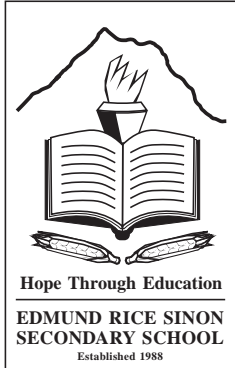

SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR FORM ONE APPLICANTS AND THEIR FAMILIES:

1. This Form costs 500/-, payable upon collection.
2. A non-refundable fee of 3 000/- is payable for the examination, payable upon the return of this form.
3. The Entrance Examination will take place as follows:
DAY ONE: Saturday, October 24th at Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School
at 9.00 am for those with a Yellow Form OR at 11.00 am for those with a Green Form.
Forms for this examination must be at the school by Wednesday, October 21st.

DAY TWO: Wednesday, January 6th at Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School
at 9.00 am for those with a Yellow Form OR at 11.00 am for those with a Green Form.
Forms for this examination must be at the school by Tuesday, January 5th.
4. This form must be returned to the school by the dates indicated above and must contain one recent passport sized picture of the student – no one will be allowed to sit the examination without their picture.
5. For the examination, students are to bring a pen only.
6. The results of the above examinations will be published at the school as follows:
For the **OCTOBER** Examination: Results will be on the School Noticeboard as from 10.00 am on Monday, October 26th.
For the **JANUARY** Examination: Results will be on the School Noticeboard as from 10.00 am on Thursday, January 7th.
7. For successful applicants, Joining Instructions will be available from the School Office immediately after the publication of results.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School is a school for both girls and boys and was started in 1988 and has expanded to include A-Level since 2005.
2. The school is managed by the Congregation of Christian Brothers for the Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha.
3. The school welcomes students of all faiths – all are offered Religion classes in their own Religion.
4. The school administration reserves the right to dismiss any student who fails to attain a specified minimum standard or whose behaviour does not deserve a place at the school.
5. Boarding accommodation is offered to both girls and boys. The 2009 fee for tuition and boarding is 600 000/- per year plus a Library and Building fee of 40 000/- for new students.
6. Hostel accommodation is also offered to both girls and boys. The 2009 fee for tuition and hostel is 500 000/- per year plus a Library and Building fee of 40 000/- for new students.
7. Day students are most welcome and comprise about one-third of our students. The 2009 fee for tuition and food is 360 000/- per year plus a Library and Building fee of 40 000/- for new students.
8. All students are offered lunch with the cost included in the school fee.
9. Fees for 2010 will be available from early November 2009 – there will be an increase in the above mentioned fees.
- 10. All accommodation costs must normally be covered by the family. Where sponsorship is offered, it is normally only available to assist with the tuition fee.**
11. Regular transport services between Friends' Corner and the school operate both morning and evening.
12. School commences at 8.15 am each day and finishes at 3.30 pm.
13. Enrolment procedures are under the direct control of the Headmaster who reserves the right to alter these guidelines in any specific instance.
