PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School started in 1988 and has expanded to include A-Level since 2005.
2. The school is managed by the Congregation of Christian Brothers for the Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha.
3. Ten combinations are under consideration but the ones to be offered by the school will depend upon the number of applications for each – it is possible that not all ten will be offered in some years.
4. The school provides boarding for approximately 80 girls and 140 boys at each year level, Form Five and Form Six. The fees are adjusted annually and the latest information on fees is available from the information provided in the Enrolment Information section of the website.
5. Day students are most welcome and comprise about one-third of our students. The fees are adjusted annually and the latest information on fees is available from the information provided in the Enrolment Information section of the website.
6. This form costs 500 shilling, payable upon collection of the form from the School Office or at interview if obtained from the website.
7. This form must be completed and returned to the school prior to, or at, the interview. A recent passport size coloured photograph must be attached before the form will be accepted and before an interview will take place.
8. **INTERVIEWS:** No student will be considered for enrolment without having attended the school for an interview with a senior member of the administration.
9. Students should ensure that the following materials are brought for the interview – and will be collected at the interview:
 - A copy of your Form Four (CSEE) Leaving Certificate
 - A copy of your Form Four (CSEE) Result Slip or a print out from the NECTA website – showing the index number
 - A copy of either your Birth Certificate or your Baptismal Card
10. A non-repayable fee of 5 000/- is payable for the interview – to be paid upon return of the form or on the day of interview.
11. Interviews will take place soon after the publication of Form Four results and will take place on school days from late February until mid to late March. The first list of students who are offered places will be published at the school and in the News or Enrolment section of the website from mid-March.
12. Students offered places must fulfil the requirements (outlined in the Joining Instructions) with regard to acceptance of a place by the stipulated date - about one week after offers are made public. **Otherwise the place is forfeited and will be offered to another student in a second round of offers in late March.**
13. This list of second round offers will also be published at the school and in the News or Enrolment section of the website. Students offered these places must fulfil the enrolment requirements by the date stipulated in the Joining Instructions - **otherwise the place is forfeited and will be offered to other applicants in a third round of offers or to late applicants.**
14. At the commencement of school, a third round of offers will be made and the instructions with regard to acceptance must be followed.
15. Classes for Forms Five and Six will commence in late March or early April depending upon the date of Easter in any year. All boarders are to in residence by 5.00 pm on the day prior to the start of classes.
16. Enrolment procedures are under the direct control of the Headmaster who reserves the right to alter these guidelines in any specific instance.
