**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Edmund Rice Sinon Secondary School started in 1988 and has expanded to include A-Level since 2005.
2. The school is managed by the Congregation of Christian Brothers for the Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha.
3. Ten combinations are under consideration but the ones to be offered by the school will depend upon the number of applications for each – it is anticipated that not all ten will be offered.
4. The school provides boarding for approximately 80 girls and 140 boys at each year level, Form Five and Form Six. The fees are adjusted annually and the latest information on fees is available from the information provided in the Enrolment Information section of the website.
5. Day students are most welcome and comprise about one-third of our students. The fees are adjusted annually and the latest information on fees is available from the information provided in the Enrolment Information section of the website.
6. This form costs 500 shilling, payable upon collection of the form from the School Office or at interview if obtained from the website.
7. This form must be completed and returned to the school prior to, or at, the interview. A recent passport size coloured photograph must be attached before the form will be accepted and before an interview will take place.
8. **INTERVIEWS:** No student will be considered for enrolment without having attended the school for an interview with a senior member of the administration and an entrance examination.
9. Students should ensure that the following materials are brought for the interview – and will be collected at the interview:
  - A copy of your Form Four (CSEE) Leaving Certificate
  - A copy of your Form Four (CSEE) Result Slip or a print out from the NECTA website – showing the index number
  - A copy of a Form Five Report from your current school.
  - A copy of either your Birth Certificate or your Baptismal Card
10. A non-repayable fee of 5 000/- is payable for the interview – to be paid upon return of the form or on the day of interview. Applications for Form Six entry must be received at the school by the Monday prior to the Entrance Interview examination or be brought to the examination.
11. Interview examinations (in the three subjects of the proposed Combination) and personal interviews will take place at the school in mid-March on a date specified on the Application Form or available from the school. The examination will take three hours. The list of students who are offered places will be published at the school within three days of the sitting of the examination.
12. Students offered places must fulfil the requirements (outlined in the Joining Instructions) with regard to acceptance of a place by the stipulated date. **Otherwise the place is forfeited and may be offered to another student in a second round of offers in late March or to late applicants.**
13. Classes for Forms Five and Six will commence in late March or early April depending upon the date of Easter in any year. All boarders are to in residence by 5.00 pm on the day prior to the start of classes.
14. Enrolment procedures are under the direct control of the Headmaster who reserves the right to alter these guidelines in any specific instance.
